Welcome to Nathaniel Cole Park

Nathaniel Cole Park is named after a Revolutionary War veteran who settled with his family in 1795 in an area that eventually came to be called Cole's Hill. With his son, Nathaniel Cole, Jr., he built a tavern on the corner of what is now Colesville Rd. and North Rd. The tavern became a stopping place for the stage coach in route from Binghamton to Albany. Part of the land once owned by Nathaniel Cole now comprises the Broome County Park that bears his name.

Cole Park has a beautiful 53-acre lake. A 1.25 mile trail encircles the lake. Two picnic areas, four picnic shelters, playgrounds, boat rentals, great fishing, and concession stand is opened Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day.


