

AD HOC COMMITTEE ON REDISTRICTING MEETING MINUTES
November 23, 2021

The Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting of the Broome County Legislature met remotely on Tuesday, November 23, 2021, via Zoom Videoconferencing.
