

AD HOC COMMITTEE ON REDISTRICTING MEETING MINUTES  
December 28, 2021

The Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting of the Broome County Legislature met remotely on Tuesday, December 28, 2021 via Zoom Videoconferencing.

The Ad Hoc Committee on Redistricting meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 5:38 PM. The Committee took the following action with regard to the matters before it:

There were several discussions regarding the County Attorney's opinion of Municipal Home Rule Law Section 34(4), when the Ad Hoc Committee should make a decision on a recommended map and forward it onto the County Legislature's County Administration Committee, potential adjustments to the draft maps, and the timeline for Legislature to consider the recommended draft map.

The following are the action items that came out of the meeting:

- Review and discussion of the County Attorney's opinion of Municipal Home Rule Law Section 34(4) with the Committee.
- Mr. Pasquale made a motion, seconded by Mr. Bertoni, to accept Draft Map 3 and forward that as the recommended map to the County Administration Committee of the County Legislature.
- Mr. Whalen made a motion, second by Mr. D.D. Reynolds, to table Mr. Pasquale's motion to accept Draft Map 3 until a meeting on Tuesday, January 4, 2021.

Mr. Whalen's Motion Failed. Ayes-4, Nays-5 (D.J. Reynolds, O'Brien, Pasquale, Bertoni, Hanrahan)

Mr. Pasquale's Motion Carried. Ayes-6, Nays-3 (Whalen, D.D. Reynolds, M. Johnson)

- Draft Map 3 was accepted as the Ad Hoc Committee's recommended map and it will be forwarded to the County Administration Committee of the County Legislature and, if approved there, will be forwarded to the entire Legislature for their full consideration.

There being no further business to come before the Committee at this time, a motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Pasquale, seconded by Mr. Bertoni. The meeting adjourned at 6:25 PM.
