The Broome County Sheriff's Office made the following arrest yesterday:

On Thursday, September 1, 2022, at about 4:00 pm, deputies were dispatched to a property damage motor vehicle accident involving two vehicles on Interstate 86 in the Town of Windsor. While investigating the accident deputies noted that the operator of one of the vehicles, Michael Morgan, was displaying signs of impairment. Morgan was asked to participate in field sobriety testing which he performed poorly on. Morgan was placed under arrest under the suspicion of operating a motor vehicle while impaired by drugs. He was transported to the Sheriff's Office headquarters where he was evaluated by a certified drug recognition expert. During the evaluation, Morgan agreed to provide a sample of his blood for analysis. Morgan was processed on the charge of driving while his ability was impaired by drugs and released on tickets returnable to the Town of Windsor Court. His vehicle was towed from the scene of the accident.
