



BROOME COUNTY SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS UNIT TASK FORCE

PRESS RELEASE

November 8, 2023

On November 7, 2023, the Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force concluded an investigation into the sale of narcotics by executing a search warrant at 44 Narwood St in Johnson City, NY. During a search of the residence investigators located and seized the following items:

- Approximately 4.3 grams of Fentanyl pills
- 123 Oxycodone Pills
- Drug paraphernalia items consisting of digital scales and packaging materials commonly used in the sale in distribution of controlled substances.
- An illegally possessed and loaded Hi-Point 9mm handgun.

As a result of the investigation, Donald D Galloway, a 37-year-old male was charged with the following:

- Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 2nd Degree-Loaded Firearm-Class C Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Weapon in the 3rd Degree-Prior Conviction-Class D Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree-Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree-Class C Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5th Degree-Class D Felony

- Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree (two counts)-
Class A Misdemeanor

Additionally, Tyana M Campbell, a 21 year old female, was charged with the following:

- Criminal Possession of a Firearm-Class E Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 3rd Degree-
Class B Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 4th Degree-Class
C Felony
- Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the 5th Degree-Class
D Felony
- Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the 2nd Degree (two counts)-
Class A Misdemeanor

Galloway and Campbell were processed on their charges at the Johnson City Police Department and then transported to the Broome County CAP to await arraignment.

The Broome County Special Investigations Unit Task Force is comprised of members of the Broome County Sheriff's Office, the City of Binghamton Police Department, and the Village of Johnson City Police Department.
