The Broome County Sheriff's Office made the following arrest last evening:

On Thursday, September 29, 2022, at about 9:45 p.m., deputies responded to a report of a motor vehicle accident on Conklin Road in the Town of Conklin. Witnesses reported seeing a vehicle traveling south on Conklin Road leave its lane of travel and drive into a ditch on the side of the road. The operator of the vehicle, Conor Collins, was able to exit the vehicle under his own power and was uninjured.

Collins displayed signs and clues of alcohol intoxication. He was asked to perform field sobriety tests which he performed poorly on. Collins was placed under arrest for the suspicion of driving while intoxicated. The subsequent investigation determined his privilege to operate a motor vehicle in New York State was previously suspended. The vehicle he was operating was towed from the accident scene.

Collins was transported to the Sheriff's Office headquarters for additional investigation and arrest processing. While at the Sheriff's Office Collins submitted to a chemical test of his breath and he was found to have a .08% blood alcohol content. He was issued traffic tickets for the offenses listed below and directed to appear in Court at a later date upon his release from custody.

Aggravated unlicensed operation 3rd degree, a misdemeanor
Unlicensed operation, a violation
