

## **FEMA Disaster Recovery Assistance Recorded Information Line – May 6, 2005**

Renters, homeowners and business owners who sustained losses as a result of the spring storms and flooding of April 2-4, 2005 may apply for Disaster Assistance at the State/Federal Disaster Recovery Center located at 90 Bevier Street, Binghamton. Starting on May 2, the center will be open seven days a week from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. until further notice. At the Disaster Recovery Center you can:

- Check on the status of your application
- Meet with FEMA & State disaster experts
- Talk with representatives from New York State agencies
- Talk with U.S. Small Business Administration experts about low-interest loans for homeowners, renters and businesses
- Get insurance questions answered, and
- Obtain information on how to reduce future damage

Residents may also register for disaster assistance by calling 1-800-621-3362, for TTY users 1-800-462-7585, Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. until further notice, or online at [www.fema.gov](http://www.fema.gov) 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
