Mr. Shaw thought the project would be a big help to the Maine-Endwell School District and that there would be a trickle-down benefit to the community if the funding was approved. Mr. D. J. Reynolds stated that the Hotel/Motel Committee approved the Town of Maine's application for \$60,0000 and questioned why the Resolution is for \$40,000. It was Mr. Palmer's understanding that the County Executive reduced the amount. Responding to a question from Mr. Flagg, Mr. Palmer stated that, if approved, the project would likely begin in the spring of 2019. It was suggested that maybe the funding could be budgeted for 2019. Mr. Sopchak would like to see more documentation from NYSEG regarding the project.
