Andrew Erickson scored a game high 21 points and Greene held Windsor to 4 points over the final 10:15 en route to a 64-55 win in the opener of the STOP DWI Holiday Classic at Seton Catholic Central High School.

Jordan Starley (11 points) and Jack Beattie (18 points) hit back-to-back three pointers to give Windsor a 51-43 lead with 2:15 left in the third quarter, its biggest lead of the game.

Greene responded as Evan Walters got the rebound off a missed free throw and layed it in. Then, after a pair of free throws, Erickson hit his 5th three pointer of the game to give the Trojans a 53-52 lead, which they would never relinquish.

Greene opened up an 18-10 lead with 1:58 left in the first quarter, but Windsor ended it with a 7-0, highlighted by KJ Hagley's three pointer at the buzzer.

The Black Knights went on a 12-4 run to start the second quarter, as Jordan Starley hit a lay-in and a 3 pointer. Windsor outscored Greene 17-11 in the second quarter to take a 34-29 lead at the half.

Greene was led by Erickson's 21 points. Nathan Parker added 14 points, Evan Walters had 11 points and Nathan Barry added 8 points, 10 rebounds and 6 assists to lead the Trojans.

Beattie had 18 points and 7 rebounds to lead Windsor. Nick Riley added 13 points and 8 rebounds and Starley had 11 points before fouling out with about a minute and a half left.

Greene will take on Seton Catholic Central in the championship game on Saturday at 6:45. Windsor will take on Marathon in the consolation game, starting at 5 p.m.

Brett Rumpel scored a game high 26 points and Marcus Dyes had 20 points and 10 rebounds as Seton beat Marathon 71-42 in the second game of the STOP DWI Holiday Classic.

After a back and forth first quarter, Seton turned it on, paced by Rumpel and Dyes. Rumpel had two dunks, Dyes had a layin and a three pointer to open up a 39-23 lead. Seton ended the first half on a 19-1 run over the final 4:22 and led 46-23 at the half.

The third quarter also belonged to the Saints, with Rumpel pouring in 7 points. Andrew Tillotson beat the third quarter buzzer to cut the Saints lead to 66-38.

Marathon was led by Conor Holland's 13 points and 6 rebounds. Diego Castellot scored 12 points, including a 3 pointer in the first half for his 1,000 career point. He's also the career school leader in 3 point baskets made.

Seton Catholic Central will take on Greene in the championship game on Saturday at 6:45. Marathon will take on Windsor in the consolation game, starting at 5 p.m. Both of those games will follow the Aldo Rossi Police memorial basketball game, which starts at 3 p.m.
