2019 Schedule
 - School Threat Assessment Training Workshop held 5/8/19
- 3) **HMEP 2019-2020 Grant**
 - Deadline May 13, 2019
 - The HMEP grant program prioritizes efforts that lead to the prevention of serious hazmat transportation related incidents, principally those of high consequence to people and the environment. All activities must be related to preparedness for the transportation of hazardous materials under this program.
 - **2019-20 HMEP Grant Program continues to emphasize preparedness for the bulk transportation of energy products by rail and over the road.**
 - Total of \$5172 available per county
- 4) **EPA Risk Management Plan (RMP) Update:**
 - **LEPC/Emergency Services needs to determine a plan to coordinate with RMP facilities. This can be an opportunity for the teams to learn and exercise different HazMat scenarios.**
 - Federal Dept. of Homeland Security also wants to see drills regarding their Chemicals of Interest and in particular, those on their theft and diversion list.
