RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE DISABILITY AWARENESS PROGRAM GRANT FOR THE OFFICE FOR AGING AND ADOPTING A PROGRAM BUDGET FOR 2020-2021

WHEREAS, the Director for the Office for Aging requests authorization to accept a Disability Awareness Program Grant and adopt a program budget in the amount of \$21,875 for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021 and

WHEREAS, said program grant allows for the collaboration with the Office for People with Disabilities to create staff and community awareness and training opportunities on how to best serve seniors with intellectual disabilities and/or seniors cohabitating or raising people/children with intellectual disabilities, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes and approves acceptance of \$21,875 from New York State Office for Aging, Empire State Agency Building 2, Albany, New York 12223-1251 for the Office for Aging's Disability Awareness Program Grant for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2021, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby approves and adopts the program budget annexed hereto as Exhibit "A" in the total amount of \$21,875, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered to execute any such agreements, documents, or papers, approved as to form by the Department of Law, as may be necessary to implement the intent and purpose of this Resolution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative is hereby empowered (with the approval of the grantor agency) to reduce the time period of the grant provided there is no change in the grant budget or extend the terms of the grant agreement for the purpose of expending any unexpended grant funds, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive or his duly authorized representative (including the Budget Director, Comptroller and/or Commissioner of Finance) is hereby authorized to make any transfers of funds required within this grant budget provided that employee head count is not increased, the County's contribution is not increased, and the salary rate or salary total for a position is not changed.

RESOLVED, that this County Legislature hereby authorizes the sale of Tax Map #118.06-1-14, 3303 NYS Route 79 in the Town of Colesville, Tax Map #211.09-1-7, 179 Main Street in the Town of Kirkwood and 125 Nowlan Road in the Town of Fenton, Tax Map# 129.06-1-30 to the Broome County Land Bank, P.O. FURTHER RESOLVED, that the revenue hereinabove referenced shall be credited to budget line 17000001.5000517.1010 (Sale of Real Property), and be it

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PERSONNEL CHANGE REQUESTS FOR THE OFFICE OF
THE BROOME COUNTY SHERIFF**

WHEREAS, the Broome County Sheriff recognizes an inequality of the salary structure within the Broome County Jail in which the current Correction Captain salary is less than the salaries of the positions immediately supervised, and

WHEREAS, as part of this resolution the Broome County Sheriff has recommended increasing the salary of the current Correction Captain, to Union Code 07, BAPA, Grade 28, Step 5, to the annual salary of \$93,114, which is above the annual minimum salary of \$80,321, and

WHEREAS, the current Correction Captain is qualified for said position and has experience and/or education which justify said salary, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that in accordance with a request contained in PCR #1759 from the Broome County Sheriff, this County Legislature hereby authorizes the increase in salary for the current Correction Captain, from Grade 26, Union Code 07, BAPA, minimum salary \$72,819, 40 hours weekly, budget line 6001000.1010.23010003 to Grade 28, Union Code 07, BAPA, to the annual salary \$93,114, 40 hours weekly, budget line 6001000.1010.23010003 effective August 1, 2021, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with a request contained in PCR #1758 from the Broome County Sheriff, this County Legislature hereby abolishes the position of Fiscal Manager, Grade 17, Union Code 07, BAPA, minimum annual salary of \$44,121, 37.5 hours weekly, Full-Time, budget line 6001000.1010.23020403 effective August 1, 2021, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that in accordance with a request contained in PCR #1757 from the Broome County Sheriff, this County Legislature hereby creates the position of Fiscal Services Administrator, Grade 24, Union Code 09, Admin 1, minimum annual salary of \$61,380, 40 hours weekly, Full-Time, budget line 6001000.1010.23020403 effective August 1, 2021.
