Mr. Capozzi stated that there was an extremely competitive bidding process to secure the boys basketball championship. The County bid at no cost to NYSPHSAA with Section 4 also offering to put up \$30,000 to secure the tournament in Binghamton. He further stated that Section 4 will be raising additional funds to offset the cost of the tournament and that it should generate significate revenue to the local economy.

Mr. Evangelisti stated that there were 17 RFP responses for this service and although Killis Almond is from Texas, they are licensed in New York and local firm Keystone Associates is the main subcontractor for this agreement. He further stated that the \$50,000 for this contract is part of a \$350,000 Brownfield Opportunity Areas (BOA) Grant the County received.

Mrs. Kradjian stated that Killis Almond has extensive experience working within the Arts and Theatre Community and that the Architectural Master Plan will focus on both the Goodwill Theatre and the Firehouse Stage.
