## "A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 214 OF THE BROOME COUNTY CHARTER AND CODE TITLED FEES AND CHARGES"

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Broome as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 214 of the Broome County Charter and Code is hereby amended to add:

## ARTICLE III Special Hauling Permit Fees.

## Section 2. §214-3. Fees and charges.

The following fees and charges are established for the issuance of a special hauling permit as follows:

A. One truck making one trip	Administrative Fee	\$100.00
	Permit Fee	\$ 10.00
	Total	\$110.00
B. Road Maintenance Agreement *	Administrative Fee	\$100.00
	Permit Fee	\$ 10.00
	Total	\$110.00

<sup>\*</sup> Pursuant to §100-4 of the Broome County Charter and Code the issuance of a Road Maintenance Agreement shall be subject, in addition to the permit fee, to such additional terms as may be reasonably required by the Commissioner of Public Works.

Section 3. This Local Law shall become effective on March 1, 2012 and upon filing with the Secretary of State.
