A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 112 - PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Broome as follows:

Section 1. § 112-1. Payments into credit unions, or other organizations permitted by law and as authorized by the Director of the Office of Management and Budget; regulations.

The Director of Management and Budget of the County of Broome is hereby authorized to deduct from the wages or salary of any employee of the County such amount that such employee may specify, in writing, filed with such appropriate fiscal officer, for payment to or deposit in any duly organized or existing credit union, or other organizations permitted by law and as authorized by the Director of the Office of Management and Budget and to transmit the sum so deducted to said credit union, as specified by the employee, for application to the account of that employee or other organization, for application to the account of that employee or organization, as applicable. Any such written authorization may be withdrawn by such employee at any time by filing written notice of the withdrawal, and the withdrawal shall be effective upon the filing thereof.

Section 2. This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State.
