Trunk or Treaters will spend the afternoon driving from trunk to trunk, collecting candy from local organizations, businesses and clubs who have decorated their vehicles to serve as the backdrop for this family friendly event. "Trunkers" will be asked to decorate their trunk, tailgate or hatchback and provide candy and treats for the "treaters". Prizes will be given out to the best decorated trunks.

## **RULES**

- Please be aware this is a non-traditional Trunk or Treat, there are strict guidelines that MUST be adhered to in order to participate.
- Each car that is participating in the Trunk or Treat will be spaced at least 25 feet apart-a parking spot on each side of the participating car will give more than the allotted social distance.
- Maximum number of trunks allowed for the event will be 25. Registration for this event is free, however all registrations are due by Wednesday, October 28. Registration is limited.
- No more than 2 people allowed with the decorated trunk/car.
- All participants must provide their OWN candy (factory sealed) for distribution, Broome County Parks will not provide candy.
- Candy will be handed to Trunk or Treaters through the car window. Vehicles handing out candy will be masked and will wear gloves as well (sanitizer and gloves will be provided to registered trunks).
- Approximately 1,000 attendees are anticipated. Please plan accordingly to avoid running out of candy early.
- Attendees and Trunks will be REQUIRED to wear a mask.
- Trunk or Treaters will be prohibited from getting out of their cars
- No amplified music.

- No electricity will be provided.
- Selling and distribution of promotional literature is prohibited at this event.
- Participants may include a sign with their display, indicating the name of the business or organization, if desired; signs may not exceed 11x17 inches.
- Vehicles may arrive beginning at 9:30 a.m. but no later than 10:15 a.m. and must be decorated and ready to go by 11 a.m.
- Vehicles will not be permitted to move or leave the parking lot until the conclusion of the event.
- All vehicles will be assigned an entry number.
- Decorations must be family appropriate.
- Trunk or Treat will enter from the North Shelter and follow the established traffic pattern already on the roadway.
- No more than 2 people allowed with the decorated trunk/car.
