


Hawkins Pond Cross Country Ski Trails



Welcome to Winter at Hawkins Pond!

Looking for a wilderness ski experience? Broome County Parks' Hawkins Pond Nature Area, and the adjacent New York State Hawkins Pond State Forest, offer a combined 6.75 miles of ski trails for beginners to experts.

These ungroomed trails provide an opportunity to ski in a wilderness setting, with several points of interest and much natural beauty along the way.

There is no charge to ski on these trails, and equipment rentals are not available. Trails are open daylight hours.

- Ski with a partner for safety
- Stay on the trails
- Yield to the right when being passed

6.5 miles of groomed trails at Greenwood Park offer skiing and snowshoeing opportunities for all, from beginners to experts!

All trails begin and end at the Park Office Ski Concession.

- Bring your own equipment (Purchase a Daily or Season Trail Pass at the Park Office.)
- OR
- Rent skiing/snowshoeing equipment at the Park Office (no trail pass required.)
