## ACADEMIC TUTOR

**DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:** Under the supervision of the Building Principal, the Academic Tutor provides tutorial assistance to under-prepared students in the areas of math, reading, or writing. The incumbent assists the students to achieve higher academic performance and become more successful. Supervision is not a responsibility of this position. Does related work as required.

## TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Provides tutorial assistance to students, either individually or in small groups;
- Creates an effective educational climate through proper supervision and classroom management;

Implements guidelines and strategies for students;

- Provides information to teachers as requested (student attendance, content covered, etc.) to establish congruence between the tutorial program and the educational program;
- Monitors each student's progress and adjusts the tutorial program accordingly;
- Attends parent or teacher conferences as required;
- Brings immediate concerns regarding students to the Principal's attention;
- Completes required reports on assigned students re: progress and concerns, as requested;

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of the academic environment;

Working knowledge of sound educational methods and procedures;

Ability to maintain a relationship with the student in order to assist with educational difficulties;

Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing; Sound judgement;

Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** Graduation for high school or possession of an equivalency diploma.
