DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves the responsibility for assisting with female suspects and female prisoners held in lock-up. Immediate supervision is received from a police officer or higher ranking supervising officer. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Assists in charging and detaining female suspects and prisoners; Receives female prisoners and places them in lock-up;

Guards female prisoners and makes physical checks according to lock-up procedures;

Watches for unusual activities by the female prisoners and reports findings to the supervisor;

Accompanies female prisoners to and from courts and other institutions;

May administer first aid.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of law enforcement procedures; Working knowledge of the typical behavior of female suspects and prisoners; Working knowledge of first aid procedures; Ability to observe, interpret and report on the female prisoner's activities; Ability to communicate effectively; Ability to deal with female suspects and prisoners firmly yet courteously; Ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; Good judgement; Dependability; Physical condition commensurate with the demand of the position.
