## WATER DISTRIBUTION OPERATOR TRAINEE

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is a trainee position in which the incumbent learns the duties and routines for performing semi-skilled work in the maintenance and repair of a municipal water distribution system. The work is performed under the general supervision of a higher level employee. Employees are required to complete the training and experience requirements from the New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Public Water Supply Protection for a certificate appropriate to the system and will be advanced to the operator level without further examination upon satisfactory completion of the certificate requirements. Does related work as required.

## TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Performs study and reading assignments, and observes demonstrations, while learning the techniques of the operation and maintenance of a water distribution system; Learns to install, maintain and repair underground water mains and other associated components including hydrants, water mains, water service lines, valves and pumps; Learns to operate motor and other equipment related to the installation, maintenance and repair of water distribution systems including back hoes, trucks, drills, and locating devices; Learns to test for and repair leaks in mains and services; Learns to read meters and record data; Learns to flush hydrants and operate bleeders; Learns to install and repair hydrants and meters; Learns to initiate and terminate water service as appropriate; Learns to respond to customers inquires and complaints regarding water service; Performs custodial duties in connection with the maintenance and repair of the distribution system's buildings and grounds, vehicles and equipment; Performs duties of increasing responsibility as assigned in the maintenance and repair of the water distribution system.

## FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

Working knowledge of simple arithmetic calculations; Ability to learn the principles and procedures of the maintenance and repair of a water distribution system; Ability to develop skill in the operation and maintenance of tools and equipment used in the installation, repair and maintenance of a water distribution system; Ability to develop skill in the installation, maintenance and repair of underground water mains and other associated components including hydrants, water mains, water service lines, valves and pumps; Ability to learn to read, understand and record data from meters; Ability to understand and carry out verbal and written instructions; Ability to get along well with others; Mechanical aptitude; Good judgment; Dependability; Alertness.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Graduation from high school or possession of a general equivalency diploma.

<u>NOTE:</u> Employees in this position may be required to work/be on call evenings and weekends.
