### WATER/WASTEWATER MAINTAINER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The incumbent in this position is responsible for performing semi-skilled work in the installation. maintenance and repair of a municipal distribution system and/or wastewater collection system. work is performed under the general supervision of a higher employee. This position differs from that οf level in Water/Wastewater Maintenance Crew Chief that Water/Wastewater Maintainer does not routinely oversee the work of a crew or have final responsibility for safety and the work performed. Does related work as required.

#### TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Installs, maintains and repairs underground water and wastewater mains and other associated components including hydrants, valves and pumps;
- Assists in the installation, testing and repair of back-flow prevention devices or directly installs, tests and repairs devices;
- Operates motor and other equipment related to the installation, maintenance and repair of water distribution and/or wastewater collection systems including back hoes, trucks, air compressors, drills and lathes, sewer cameras and locating devices;

Performs pressure tests and chlorinates water mains;
Tests for and repairs leaks in mains and services;
Makes minor repairs on small pumps and equipment;
Cleans and repairs storm and sanitary sewer lines;
Flushes hydrants and operates bleeders;
Repairs and installs hydrants and meters
Responds on an on-call basis to water and wastewater system problems.

# FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS:

- Good knowledge of the principles, practices, tools, equipment, terminology and safety precautions involved in the maintenance of the water distribution and sanitary sewer systems;
- Working knowledge of the operation and repair of pumps and compressors;

- Working knowledge of municipal ordinances related to water transmission and wastewater collection;
- Working knowledge of municipal geography;
- Ability to perform semi-skilled and other tasks related to water transmission/distribution and wastewater collection systems;
- Ability to safely and effectively use tools and operate equipment related to water and wastewater systems maintenance and repair;
- Ability to keep minor records in the use of materials, supplies and equipment;
- Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions.

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- A) Two years of experience in the maintenance and repair of water distribution and/or wastewater collection systems; OR
- B) Two years of experience in semi-skilled plumbing work or as a plumber's helper.

## SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

Possession of a valid New York State driver's license appropriate to the vehicles operated.
