## Office for Aging Shopper Bus

**A great opportunity to get your shopping done!**



The Office for Aging (OFA) offers weekly scheduled bus trips for Senior Housing residents. This service provides transportation to and from various grocery stores and shopping centers in the community.

This service is offered to those aged 60 and older with an Office for Aging ID card. Call **(607) 778-2411** to request a free ID Card application. Riders 60 and older may use this service for a suggested contribution of \$1.50 per one-way ride. Contributions are confidential and voluntary. No one is denied service if they are unable to contribute. No reservation necessary for those 60 and older. Just be present at the pickup times listed.

Those under the age of 60 & disabled may participate **ONLY** if they have an ADA card. **These riders must call (607) 763-8747** to make a reservation for the BC Lift in order to participate. Those under age 60 may participate for a charge of \$2.50 per one-way ride.

## **Shopper Bus Policy**

### **Office for Aging Shopping Trips**

OFA Shopper Bus trips are group trips offered specifically for residents of various senior housing buildings. These trips provide transportation to and from local grocery stores on certain days of the week. On these trips, passengers must adhere to the following rules:

- Grocery items must be limited to three paper or six plastic bags. Shoppers are encouraged to bring fabric bags with handles to carry their groceries.
- Purchases of one case of water bottles or one case of soda would take the place of one paper bag or two plastic bags.
- The items must be stored on the passenger's lap or on the floor between their feet and cannot obstruct the aisle. This will ensure that if there is a sudden stop, the items will stay in place.
- Carts are allowed; however, they must fit between the passenger and the seat in front of them with the groceries inside and cannot obstruct the aisle.
