

City of Binghamton, New York Aging Demographics Fact Sheet




In 2010, residents age 60+ made up 20.8% of the City of Binghamton population. This is a decline from the 1990 (23.8%) and 2000 (21.7%) Census data. The 2016 Census data estimates that residents 60+ made up 22.7% of the City of Binghamton population. Between 1990 and 2016 the 60+ population declined by 16.9%.

2. Total Age Group Population Change 1990 to 2016


