### **PRESS RELEASE**

**April 8th, 2021**

**The Broome County Sheriff's Office made the following arrest on April 7, 2021:**

**On April 7, 2021 at about 8:05am, the Broome County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of a Volvo tractor stopped in the lane of travel on Upper Front St. in the Town of Dickinson and the driver was not responsive. Deputies arrived on scene and located the driver, identified as Sircurtis King, of Binghamton, in the driver's seat rocking back and forth with his eyes closed. King displayed clues and behaviors indicative of being under the influence of an unknown substance. During the investigation a field sobriety test was given which King performed poorly on. King was ultimately arrested under the suspicion of driving while his ability was impaired. He was transported to the Sheriff's Office headquarters for further testing and investigation. At the Sheriff's Office, a drug recognition expert conducted an examination and determined King was impaired and unable to operate a motor vehicle safely. King was released on appearance tickets and directed to appear in the Town of Dickinson Court at a later time. The Volvo tractor was towed from the roadway.**
