Traffic Stop Leads to Arrest for Outstanding Warrant, Driving with a Suspended License and other charges

(BINGHAMTON, NY) A routine traffic stop on Conklin Ave. in Binghamton led to an arrest on an outstanding warrant for aggravated harassment charges on Sunday.

On April 2, 2023, Broome County Sheriff's Office deputies observed a parked car at the Speedway Gas Station on the corner of Conklin Ave. and Tompkins St. and identified the driver as Jesse J. Roberts, age 26 of Broome County. Roberts was sought for pending charges of aggravated harassment after allegedly sending threatening messages to a woman and was taken into custody.

Further investigation found Roberts had been driving with an open container of alcohol and six open license suspensions for failing to appear in court for traffic tickets on three different occasions over the past 3 years.

Jesse J. Roberts was charged with Aggravated Harassment in the 2nd Degree, a Class A Misdemeanor per the outstanding warrant and issued the following tickets:

- Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle, a Violation
- Aggravated Unlicensed Operation of a Motor Vehicle with 3 or more open suspensions in the 2nd Degree, a Violation
- Operating an Unregistered Motor Vehicle on a Highway, a Violation
- Operating a Motor Vehicle with Improper Plates, a Violation
- Drinking Alcohol or Using Cannabis in a Motor Vehicle on the Highway, a Violation
- Failure to Notify the DMV of a Change of Residence, a Violation

Roberts was taken to the Central Arraignment Part Court at the Broome County Correction Facility for arraignment.
