Dear Broome County Resident:

Thank you for your traffic safety concern and seeking a Speed Trailer. These Speed Trailers are variable message signs that display speeds, messages and records traffic data. They are designed to make motorists aware of the speed limit and/or special hazards.

Once the Speed Trailer has been deployed for 1-2 weeks max, the traffic data from it gets analyzed. If the data indicates a significant speed problem, this information will be relayed to our Deputies who *will try* to conduct traffic enforcement when not answering calls, or patrolling other areas.

The data received from the speed trailer can be requested at any time. There will be times where the Speed Trailer does not display any messages, but is in a discrete mode that is just recording speeds and volume of traffic.

If you would like to have a Speed Trailer near or on your property, we request that you complete the general waiver release form and mail it back to us. Once the waiver is received, your location will be put on a list in order from when it was received. If you do have a Speed Trailer posted on or near your property, we kindly ask to you keep note of it to ensure it does not get vandalized.

GENERAL RELEASE

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, OR MAY CONCERN,
