The successful bidder shall agree and stipulate that the status of said LICENSED JOURNEYMAN PLUMBER, while performing any services pursuant to this bid, is that of an employee of the successful bidder, and will not hold himself out as, or claim to be an employee, officer or agent of the County, or Department of Public Works, in any manner whatsoever, including, but not limited to, Worker's Compensation insurance, unemployment insurance, medical or health insurance, civil service status, union membership, retirement membership or pension plan benefits.

The successful bidder must have available on staff, a plumber certified to do back flow prevention testing, and shall also have on staff two (2) plumbers that holds a NYS Department of Labor Allied Trades certification that allows them to work in areas containing asbestos.

Proof of certification must be supplied to Broome County within 60 days of an award. Failure to obtain and supply the requested certification within the stipulated time period will result in an immediate cancellation of the contract.

PRICING

All bids shall be made on a HOURLY RATE* basis for: a.) straight time, b.) overtime at time and a half the regular rate, and c.) overtime at double the hourly rate, in combination with a contractor's percentage markup for overhead and profit. (Item D1 and D2 on Page 12).

The final HOURLY RATE* will include any and all costs to furnish a LICENSED JOURNEYMAN PLUMBER for Broome County.

** The hourly rate proposed must be calculated in compliance with the attached NYS Department of Labor Prevailing Rate Schedule. The hourly rate includes the base rate plus all fringe benefits, including social security.*

PERCENTAGE MARKUP FOR OVERHEAD AND PROFIT BY THE CONTRACTOR

The percentage markup will be a percentage of the Straight Time or Overtime as may be applicable and this percentage will remain constant for the life of this contract, including all renewals.

AWARD

Award shall be made to the responsive and responsible bidder proposing the lowest price, whose proposal complies with all provisions to render it formal and legal.

Proposals will be evaluated using the following formula:

800 hours at STRAIGHT TIME (A.4 X 800)	\$ 63,616.00
100 hours at TIME AND ONE-HALF (B.4 x 100)	\$ 9,888.00
50 hours at DOUBLE TIME (C.4 x 50) \$ 5,941.50	
Materials and Supplies: \$2000 + Contractors % for handling: (\$2000 x D.1 +\$2000)	\$ 2,200.00
Specialty Subcontractor Services: \$2,000 + Contractors % for handling: (\$2000 x D.2 +\$2000)	\$ 2,180.00
TOTALS	<u>83,825.50</u>

These estimates are for the purpose of evaluating contractors' prices and to recommend an award to the County Board of Contract and Supply. No minimum or maximum amount of work is guaranteed by the use of this example.

NOTE: Cash discounts, offered by bidders for accelerated payment, will **NOT** be considered in the evaluation of proposals.

Broome County reserves the right to reject any and all bids not considered to be in the best interests of Broome County.

Bidders may withdraw their bids if no award has been made within forty-five (45) days of bid opening.
